

## Glasgow Music Festival Association

Glasgow Music Festival Association is a Scottish charity that promotes participation and interest in performing arts. Formed in 1910, it created Glasgow Music Festival, an annual festival of music, dance, speech and drama.

Each festival provides a public platform for over 7,000 performers in a full and varied programme of events spanning the two weeks commencing the first Saturday in March.

Performers have the opportunity to develop their skills using advice and encouragement given by a team of experienced adjudicators. In addition, they can benefit from observing other performances and through meeting fellow participants from across Scotland and other parts of the United Kingdom.

Although much of each festival centres around young people, amateur performers of all ages take part. There are events for groups of almost any size and description in addition to an extensive programme for solo performance.

Performers at each festival have wide-ranging experience and abilities. Some are 'high flyers' who will become professional performers with flourishing international careers. For many, however, music, dance, speech and drama will remain worthwhile interests which provide enjoyment and valuable recreation.

In addition to the annual Festival, the Association supports concerts and other events. These provide Festival participants with further performance opportunities.

Glasgow Music Festival is a festival member of The British and International Federation of Festivals for Music, Dance and Speech.
